Old Business

Snowmobile Trail Signs/Fencing Removals:

The three Log Cabin Restaurant parking lot signs were removed from their locations and the orange fencing was taken down at the old Ansonia Gulf Station. Our large sign at the Burnin' Barrel was also removed and stored for next season, along with other miscellaneous signs on the trail.

Upper Pine Creek Trout Tournament (TT)

Trout Tournament Hats:

Our TT hat order from Capsmith should be arriving soon. Along with our usual design on the front of the hat, we'll be adding one free gold decorative fishhook on the brim to those who desire it.

Trout Tournament Shirts:

Our TT shirts are in production and will be available soon.

Stocking Rafts:

Two rafts have been reserved at Pine Creek Outfitters for May 13th (tournament stocking day), which will be picked up by the fish stocking crew that morning. We have increased the number of fish this year to a total of 275.

Shotgun Raffle:

We found a gun for the raffle! It's a Winchester SX-4 Universal Hunter 12 GA Semi-Auto Shotgun (Mossy Oak Camo). MSRP \$1,149. The drawing will be the first day of the trout tournament: Saturday, May 14th at 4PM. Only 225 tickets are being sold @\$10 per ticket.

We will again be using a large marquee tent like last year's setup. The tent will be in front of the clubhouse and will be set up by May 12th. In previous years, registration was carried out inside the clubhouse, but the tent setup worked so well last year, it's become a fixture for the TT!

Early Registration:
