Old Business

Dry Hollow Trail:

This trail was not worked on this spring, but we've been promised by DCNR that it will be in decent shape before the snow flies.

South Rail Bed Trail Closure:

As reported previously, the South Rail Bed east of the clubhouse is permanently closed.

New Business

North Meadow Trail:

The new route is the North Meadow Trail, and it will be improved by the club on September 24th. This route to/from our clubhouse runs to the north across Route 6, then east toward The Burnin' Barrel. It's 1.9 miles from the red barn across from The Burnin' Barrel to the clubhouse. Just follow the signs on the trail and be safe crossing Route 6 at the clubhouse and at the Burnin' Barrel. The South Rail Bed west of the clubhouse will remain open.
