North Meadow Trail:

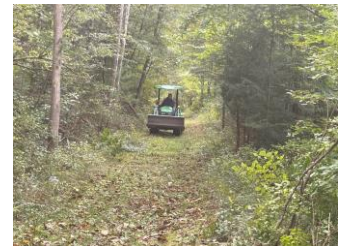
