Old Business

Update as of January 23rd – We have snow!

It snowed overnight here in Tioga and Potter counties, with an accumulation of 3+ inches. The club has its seasonal signage up to direct folks to and from our clubhouse. Let's hope the snow stays for a long while!

The recommended route using the North Meadow Trail will require two crossings of Rt. 6, so be extra careful in those places, folks.

<u>Reminder</u>: Please drive SLOWLY through the Log Cabin Inn & Restaurant parking lot!

Route Change on Left Asaph Rd. to McCarthy Trail: Normal access from the Left Asaph Rd. onto the Old Supply Trail (OST) is CLOSED. Alternate access to McCarthy Trail will be a half mile down the Left Asaph Rd. past the OST's normal access point (TI29 Orange Diamond on DCNR map); that is closed due to logging activities. This alternate route will come out onto the OST. Taking a right onto OST and riding half a mile will bring you to the top of McCarthy Trail. Note: OST is OPEN to Goodall Rd. from McCarthy Trail. In the map below, the yellow section is CLOSED, magenta section is OPEN.
